VISION HOUSE: John and Susan Camerer founded Vision House in 1990. The couple was moved to help the Greater Seattle area's homeless after seeing a heartbreaking television portrayal of a single mother who lost custody of her child after becoming homeless. Soon after, the couple wrote a personal check for \$800 to establish the ministry.

Vision House was created with the vision to make a significant contribution to the community by reducing the number of homeless men, women and children in Washington State. Although Vision House was founded on Christian principles, there are no mandatory spiritual activities for clients. Vision House's mission statement is: *To follow our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ in working with the poor and homeless to promote positive transformation of their lives.*

Vision House staff quickly realized that lack of quality child care is a major obstacle for families in transition to self-sufficiency. Children's Village Child Care opened its doors in June of 2005. Our goal is to provide a high quality, Christian-based program, meeting the child care needs of Vision House clients and the local community.

ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

Our center uses Teaching Strategies Gold which is an interactive curriculum that focus learning around the interest of the children. Parents receive two conferences per year where you will receive evidence of what your child is learning in their portfolio. We combine this with Tadpoles which tracks day to day activities and sends an electronic report at the end of each day.

INFANTS: Our infant team has been together for over 5 years with the lead staff a veteran at 14 years. These teachers have extensive training in infant care and provide a calm and nurturing atmosphere.

WADDLERS: Our waddler teachers are fluent in sign-language and enjoy teaching them in basic sign.

TODDLERS: Our teachers focus on building positive relationships and regulation of emotions.

YOUNG PRESCHOOL: Our teachers in this class work alongside parents to assist in potty training.

OLDER PRESCHOOL: Teachers use "ZOO Phonics" to assist in learning letters and sounds.

BEGINNERS PRE-K: Teachers use "Handwriting without Tears" to assist in learning to write.

CHILDREN'S VILLAGE STAFF

Our teachers serve as loving guides and models to the children, providing examples of positive relationships and instilling in them a love of learning. They work to prepare the children with the skills, abilities and motivation that will help them to understand, grow, and thrive in the world.

Our teaching staff is composed of teachers who have been with us anywhere from 1 year to 14 years.

- Our teachers are trained with a minimum of 30 hours of Child Care Basic training.
- Most teachers have degrees in Early Child Care Education.
- All of our teachers receive 10 hours of either a review or on-going early child care education every year.

- First Aid and CPR
- Blood Borne Pathogens
- Food Handlers
- Mandating Reporting
- Safe Sleep

- Emergency and Disaster preparedness
- Trauma Informed Care
- Safety and Supervision
- Positive Discipline Techniques

ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

Additional programs offered by our center are:

1. Soccer Shots once per week.
2. Webby Dance every once per week.
3. Music class once per week.

Summer field trips for preschool and PreK
